HIGHLIGHTS

- Fewer storms, but Stronger than average
- No hurricanes in the U.S., wild in the Atlantic
- Mixed impacts: mid-season shifted between quiet gaps and fierce surges
- Hurricane Melissa's 252 mph gust set an Atlantic WING Speed record
- A quiet peak season gave way to a late burst of intense storms
