## RoadDSS Manager | Action Plan Update


In the previous release, based on user requests we included additional fields to the action plan.

The new fields are non-mandatory, free-text form and appear in the New Action input box that can be accessed from either the Planning Overview or Route Planning Tab.

An adjustment has now been made to the Action Plan such that if none of the Plans have any data populated to the new parameters they will not be included in the emailed plan.



## **Additional Support for Graphs**

As previously communicated, end of life for Adobe Flash Player has required an alternative graph to be implemented.


To support accessibility, it is now possible to select individual parameters to be highlighted for emphasized focus.

To highlight one or more parameters select it by clicking on the legend. Both parameter name and the corresponding line on the graph are highlighted. To deselect, click the parameter name again.



Rain State is now selectable from the "Select" tab at the top of the graph. At least one other parameter must be selected in order for Rain State to be displayed.
